



Bradford North foodbank

Bradford North foodbank opened in early 2015 to give local people in crisis hope, practical help, and a brighter future. One in five people live below the poverty line in the UK. We provide three days' emergency food and support to local men, women and children in crisis. Our vision is to ensure that no-one in our area has to go hungry and we value all our supporters, who help us with this vision.

Food Donations

Almost all our food is generously donated by people in the local community (schools, businesses, churches and individuals) and volunteers of all backgrounds help to sort, pack, and distribute food parcels to individuals and families in need. Local people are feeding and supporting local people.

Frontline Care Professionals

The families and individuals who come to us have been referred by care professionals by means of food vouchers. Social workers, health visitors, school liaison officers and others, work with us to help people in crisis so that they do not have to go hungry.

Foodbank Distribution Centers

Voucher recipients bring their voucher to one of our foodbank distribution centres, where it is exchanged for a three-day supply of emergency food. Whilst their food is being packed, foodbank volunteers will provide light refreshments and sit with them for a chat: listening to their stories and signposting them to agencies that can offer additional support and assist them to start or progress the resolution of underlying problems. In addition to essential food supplies, we also offer essential toiletries, household cleaning products and, if we have any, dog and/or cat food.

Regular donations covering routine costs also mean we can target grant applications to specific projects designed to either give additional support to people referred to us or to upskill and care for our fantastic volunteer teams, without whom we could not run the foodbank.
